

OBSVCA All - Region Balloting Rules and Procedures

After the regional seeding meeting, all teams with active OBSVCA membership are eligible to participate in the all-star balloting. A coach or representative for his team must be at this meeting in order to have their players nominated for all-star consideration. Coaches should bring enough copies of the nomination ballot to give to each coach in their region. The nomination ballot has the key statistics and should be filled out accurately since many members use this data in evaluating players. The voting procedures will be as follows:

- Each school may nominate up to 6 players, in which, no more than 2 players may be up for consideration at the same time.
- First Team Honors are nominated first, followed by a balloting of the coaches present. Second Team Honors are next followed by Honorable Mention.
- Each coach may give a brief summary (60 second time limit) of the player they are nominating prior to the balloting.
- Voting will take place by ballot (after each team): this will be read aloud.
- Coaches may not vote for their own players, however they may vote for themselves for Coach of the Year Honors.
- Each coach will vote for the number of team honors to be awarded (for example, the coach will vote for 6 players for the first team). The player listed first will be awarded points equal to the number of positions being voted on (for example, on the First Team, the first player will receive 6 points, the second player will receive 5 points, etc.)
- Any ties for last positions on First or Second team will require a revote between those players only. Ties for the last position for Honorable Mention will not be re-voted on but the awards will be expanded to include these players.
- The highest vote recipient on the First Team will be the Player of the Year in the Region.
- Regional teams are broken down as follows:
 - First Team - 6 members (one being Player of the Year)
 - Second Team - 6 members
 - Honorable Mention - 12 members (may be adjusted to reflect the number of teams in the region)
- Coach of the Year candidates have to be nominated by another school's representative. The coach may give a brief recap of their team's accomplishments, records, etc. The highest recipient will be the Regional Coach of the Year and the next two highest vote recipients will be awarded the Regional Coaches Achievement award. These three coaches are then nominated for the State Coach of the Year Award.
- Regional award and certificates for both players and coaches should be presented at the regional finals match.
