

OBSVCA All-Star State Balloting Rules and Procedures

State Rules

1. Regional all-star coordinators will verify regional results and compile a summary for each region's top 12 players (1st and 2nd teams).
2. Each coach casts 6 votes for 1st team and 6 votes for 2nd team and 6 votes for 3rd team honors out of the 48 players on the ballot. Coaches must complete voting online by:
3. Coaches may not vote for their own players; however, they may vote for themselves, if nominated for coach of the year.
4. It is unethical to "trade" votes, please vote on the merit of the player's abilities.
5. State all-star coordinator, OBSVCA president, and committee will receive notification of the award winners to be broken down as follows:
 - First Team - 1st-6th highest point totals (1st place also recognized as "Mr. Volleyball-State MVP")
 - Second Team - 7th-12th highest point totals
 - Third Team - 13th-18th highest point totals
 - Honorable Mention - 19th-30th highest point totals
6. Tie breakers for First, Second or Third all-state players:
 - Number of first team votes received
 - Number of second team votes received
 - Number of third team votes received
 - Number of votes from outside their region
 - Percentage of votes received from home region
 - Year in School (upperclassmen given preference)
 - Team's record (higher winning percentage given preference)
7. There will be no tie-breakers for Honorable Mention, this award will be expanded to include a few more than the original 12 members.
8. State Coach of the Year will be selected from the three nominations from each region (12 coaches). The next three highest vote recipients will be awarded State Coaches Achievement awards.
9. Tie breakers for State Coach of the Year:
 - Number of votes from outside their region
 - Percentage of votes within their region
 - New recipients given precedence over repeat winner(s)
 - Team's record, achievements, etc.
10. After verification of results, all-star Coordinator and/or committee shall contact the coaches of those players receiving all-state honors. Awards will be presented at the state finals.
11. Send final results to regional representatives for distribution to local media.
